

Adjectives

I Can....Statements

1. I can differentiate between descriptive and proper adjectives.
2. I can identify definite and indefinite articles and recognize them as limiting adjectives.
3. I can identify demonstrative and possessive adjectives.
4. I can use limiting adjectives that tell how many.
5. I can identify the correct position of an adjective in a sentence and use adjective complements correctly.
6. I can identify and use the three degrees of comparisons for adjectives.

Adverb

I Can....Statements

1. I can.... Identify adverbs of time, place and manner using the questions when, where, and how.
2. I can...Identify adverbs that compare: positive, comparative and superlative degrees.
3. I can....learn the correct form irregular adverbs that compare using more/most.
4. I can use commonly confused adverbs and adjectives correctly (good/well, their/there, real/very, two/too/to, and no/not/never/any).

Nouns

I Can..... Statements

1. We can classify nouns as a person, place or thing.
2. We can distinguish & identify proper and common nouns.
3. We can identify the gender of a noun and write the plural form of nouns correctly.
4. We can recognize the subject & subjective complement written in the nominative case.
5. We can identify the noun used in a direct address.
6. We can identify the direct object of a verb and the object of the preposition.
7. We can form the possessives of plural and singular nouns.
8. We can identify and write prepositional phrases and prepositions in a sentence.

Pronouns

I Can.....Statements

1. I can name, identify, and write singular and plural personal pronouns.
2. I can identify the 3 types of personal pronouns used in sentences.
3. I can identify and use personal pronouns in the nominative & objective case used as subjective complements.
4. I can identify, use, and write the correct use of personal pronouns.
5. I can use pronouns as possessive pronouns, in contractions and as compound personal pronouns.

Verbs

I Can.....Statements

1. I can contrast the difference between action and being verbs.
2. I can identify the principal and auxiliary verbs used in verb phrases.
3. I can contrast how regular & irregular verbs are different & recognize common irregular verbs.
4. I can identify and use the three simple tenses correctly.
5. I can identify linking verbs and use subjective complements correctly in sentences.
6. I can identify transitive and intransitive verbs and use them correctly in sentences.
7. I can write sentences where subject and verb must agree.
